#### **RESTORE** Saturday, April 22

#### **ARTIST IN RESIDENCE PROGRAM**

For over four decades, Bernheim's **Artist in Residence program** has attracted artists from around the world who seek to use Bernheim as their inspiration. Up to 4 artists are selected for residencies at Bernheim on an annual basis, each with a stipend of \$2,500. Bernheim also provides living quarters and studio space in exchange for an artwork, site-specific sculpture, or temporary installation. One of the four residencies is always dedicated to a regional artist living in Kentucky or in Clark and Floyd counties of Southern Indiana. Another residency is committed to an artist whose work addresses environmental issues and climate change. Bernheim's Arts in Nature team works individually with each artist to develop programming and engagement opportunities around every site-specific artwork created during the residency.


### 1. SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS (\$150+)


